

Entertainment in Dallas

October 2017

Museums: several recommended ones are within walking distance of the Sheraton, being: “The Sixth Floor Museum” about the shooting of President Kennedy (1.0 mile, 1.6 km), Dallas Museum Of Art (0.4 mile, 0.6 km), Perot Museum of Nature and Science (1.0 mile, 1.6 km).

Recommended walk to Sixth Floor Museum: walk via Main Street and see many historic buildings. Note on your left Neiman Marcus (the first store in the USA). On the return go via Commerce Street.

Other **historic buildings** in downtown walking distance: e.g., Majestic Theater (0.2 mile, 0.3km, Elm Street), Adolphus Hotel and Magnolia Building both on Commerce Street (0.5 mile, 0.8km).

Outside the downtown area., e.g., Wilson House and the Wilson Block Historic District (1.0 mile, or 1.6 km).

Warning: although Dallas has hundred of miles of sidewalks, and is great to walk, many car drivers do not expect pedestrians. If going on long walks, always check with the hotel whether the neighborhood is safe.

Halloween: evening of Tuesday October 31. Americas 2nd most celebrated event. Kids collect candy and people go out in costume.

Cowboy culture: Dallas has no cowboy culture. To see cowboy culture visit Forth Worth (34 miles, 54.4 km) with, e.g., its rodeo, etc.

Bars. The following neighborhoods and bars are recommended. (All bars were tested, except these marked with a star.) *Make sure to bring an ID.*

²Can also be reached via Bus 24 **via Capitol**. Warning: late evening buses run only every 60 minutes. Last bus around 11:14pm via Mockingbird and then return by light train (Red Line).

³Can also be reached via Bus 1 **via Matilda** and then continue walking. Late buses only every 45 minutes towards Mockingbird and then a connection to the light train (Red Line). Last bus: 12:34.
